First Grade Summer Math Activity Log

Students are expected to spend **24 hours** or more during the summer months engaged in mathematics. This is approximately **two hours** of math practice per week. How can this occur? Students could create similar math word problems and riddles for their families and friends to solve. They could play math-related board games like Monopoly. Students could count loose change or estimate the cost and change for a purchase. They could compute the total of your grocery bill, write imaginary checks, order the weeks' temperatures, measure ingredients for a recipe, identify patterns and shapes in their environment, etc. Students can also practice their addition and/or multiplication combinations by making illustrated flash cards. There are countless ways to engage your child in mathematics. It is all around them. To assist you with supporting your child throughout the summer months, a weekly math activity log has been created. Students who successfully complete their math logs **should** submit them to their new teacher on the first day of school!
